### Discussion Questions

2. Reread Hebrews 9:1-5. In what ways did the Old Testament tabernacle help people to approach God (see also Exodus 25)? How does the author apply this to his understanding of why Jesus came (Hebrews 9:6-10)?
3. What was insufficient about the Old Testament tabernacle system? Why did it need to be "completed" in Christ?
4. Review our definition of "redemption." Why is this such an important concept when we reflect upon why and how we are saved in Jesus?
5. What does Hebrews teach you, overall, about the need for the Old Testament to properly understand and appreciate the New Testament?
6. According to Hebrews 9:11-15, what benefits do we now enjoy because of what Christ has accomplished? What are practical examples of how these are manifested in everyday life?
