FAQ's

What is the cost for ONE WKND?

The first 400 students who register will get the discounted price of \$75. Once those spots fill up, students will pay \$95.

Is confidential financial assistance available?

Yes, partial scholarships are available and based on need. All scholarships are confidential. Please contact the Student Ministry office if you need assistance or have further questions. (<u>heather.wilson@jfbc.org</u>)

How will groups be formed?

Students will request to be placed with their friends for the weekend. Our team will work to honor requests and place students based on many factors including their schools and Life Groups. If you have a special request, you will need to make our team aware by contacting <u>heather.wilson@jfbc.org</u>.

Where will my student stay for the weekend? Are these homes safe?

Students will be staying in the home of a qualified and trusted adult who is a member in good standing at Johnson Ferry. All students will be together in a shared space and sleep in sleeping bags or air mattresses. Families that are hosting for the weekend are interviewed and go through extensive training to ensure the safety of your child for the weekend. If you are interested in hosting a group for ONE WKND or even your own child's group, please register at <u>www.johnsonferry.org/onewknd</u>. Keep in mind that we are selective about our host home applicants.

Who will be leading my student through Bible Study?

Bible Studies will be led by our adult Life Group leaders and ONE WKND college-aged leaders. Each college-aged leader is interviewed and submits an application. Once they are approved, they must follow our policy guidelines and spend two days of training at Johnson Ferry Baptist Church leading into the weekend.



Will my student be allowed to drive?

Students will be allowed to drive to their host home on Friday night and Sunday morning to the final worship service. Otherwise, students WILL NOT be allowed to drive during the weekend. Only adult leaders and approved drivers can drive students.

What if my student has food and/or pet allergies?

Please indicate this on the student's registration. We will not place your student in a host home that cannot accommodate their allergy requests. If your student has a food allergy, each home will make sure there will be food available for them to eat.

Will cell phones or technology be allowed?

Students will be allowed to bring their cell phones. However, we will have a strict no-use policy during bible study sessions, worship sessions, and after bed-time. **Students may be asked to put their cell phones in a basket or bag during specific times at the weekend.

My student wants to bring a friend. Is that ok?

YES! Please encourage your student to bring their friends. We will ensure that they are placed in your students group and home for the entire weekend!

How can I, as a parent, invest in ONE WKND?
