Healing a Nation

If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land. (2 Chronicles 7:14)

In the days ahead, may God find us faithful in praying for our nation and its leaders. Prayer, and our relationships with God and others, must always take priority over politics.

If you don't know what to pray, start with Scripture. Pray that:

- God would give our leaders a spirit of wisdom and revelation so they would know Him better. Pray that the eyes of their hearts would be enlightened so that they may know the hope to which God has called them, the riches of His glorious inheritance in His holy people, and His incomparably great power for those who believe. (Ephesians 1:17-19)
- Pray for God to create a pure heart and renew a right spirit within them and each of us. (Psalm 51:10)
- Pray that they would know the truth and that the truth would set them free. (John 8:32)

SPIRITUAL GUIDELINES:

- 1. **Seek God's Perspective**: Spend time in God's presence daily, disengaging from the world and engaging with Him to understand His perspective for our nation.
- 2. **Fast Regularly**: Set aside periods of time to engage with God through fasting.
- 3. **Prioritize Prayer**: Seek God's guidance and protection for our nation and leaders.
- 4. **Pray with Your Children and Grandchildren**: Model prayer for these and involve them in praying for the nation and its leaders.
- 5. **Pray Corporately**: Join with other believers to pray for the nation, seeking unity and healing together.

RELATIONAL GUIDELINES:

- Challenge Policies, Not People: Focus on discussing policies rather than attacking individuals; respect differing viewpoints.
- Respect, Don't Ridicule: Avoid using derogatory labels and show respect to those with opposing views.
- 3. **Don't Assume a Motive**: Refrain from assuming the motives behind someone's political stance, focus on discussing methods rather than intentions.
- Focus on Experience, Not Argument: Recognize that personal experiences can be more persuasive than arguments, aim to share experiences that lead others to God.
