Car Conversations Parent Debrief Tool

Purpose

The first moment you get in the car to leave JFBC and head back to your home will be critical. You can ask the right questions or you could ask the wrong questions. Parents, we want to help you capitalize on this special moment with your student and to do that successfully we created our Car Conversations Parent/Student Debrief tool.

The hope of this tool is simple: to help you ask the right questions as your student adjusts back to normal life.

Your goal is to help your student see the difference between the trip being a souvenir and a transformation. What do we mean by that? We want this trip to be an experience for your student that has transformed their heart (by the power of the Holy Spirit). We want them to see this not as one moment, but the beginning of a transformational journey – we are all continually being shaped by our experiences. If you don't debrief, it turns the experience into a "thing that happened to you" or an "instagram post".

Sample Questions

What was the most impactful part of the trip for you? What attribute of God stood out to you on the trip? As you return to East Cobb, what do you notice? What did you learn about yourself on the trip? What do you hope is true about you moving forward? What do you want to do differently or new? What is your role in the Great Commission?

Invitations

What is a personal next step you want them to do? What is one family next step that you can implement together?. Students can start a prayer group for the nations/schools. Students can lead a 419 student discipleship group or join one.
