Camp Grace now knows from experience that, together with its partners, they are starting to break the cycle of poverty, crime, teen pregnancy and the high school dropout rate.

Camp Grace's partners are committed to changing the environment of these at-risk youth. These leaders serve at camp during the summer and follow-up by loving and mentoring the campers year-round. The gospel doesn't stop after camp!

On Wednesday, Jul 9, we will take two buses with 30 people to serve with this

great camp as a one-day mission team. We will arrive in the afternoon and focus on camp activities and worship. During worship, we will demonstrate God's great love for these children and youth by washing their feet as Jesus modeled for us.
