5. V. 33-36 are a burst of praise. What moves Paul from theology to doxology in this moment? When was the last time deep truth about God moved you to worship?

6. What does v. 36 ("For from him and through him and to him are all things") say about God's sovereignty and our purpose? How can this shape how we live day to day?
